

## Judges CV

I have owned Bullmastiffs since 1972 and became involved in the show scene in 1984. My wife Patricia and I started the Licassa affix in 1987. Between 1993 and 2011 we owned Bullmastiffs under the Licassa affix in partnership with Janet & Chris Quantrill. We have only bred very selectively and have had ten litters. We have however had some success in breeding having been Top breeders (Our Dogs Competition) in 1995, 2000 and 2007. We have bred 9 Champions and campaigned 8 dogs to their Championship. At Crufts in 2010 the double was achieved, winning both dog and bitch CC's with litter brother and sister.

I began my judging career in 1990. My judging experience includes awarding CC's in Bullmastiffs on seven occasions since 1999 and judging Bullmastiffs in Canada, USA, Switzerland, Finland, Spain and France. I also award CC's in Leonbergers, Tibetan Mastiffs and Dogue De Bordeaux. I have judged Breed Club Open Shows for Bullmastiffs, Tibetan Mastiffs, Canaan Dogs, Lancashire Heelers, Boxers, Bernese Mountain Dogs, Australian Shepherds, Rottweilers, Briards, Alaskan Malamutes, Newfoundland, Neapolitan Mastiffs and Schnauzers (all three sizes) plus Working, Pastoral, Terrier, Utility & Hound Groups and Best in Show at Open Show level as well as many breeds at Open Show level.

I served as a committee member of the Southern Bullmastiff Society from 1988 to 1995 and Secretary from 1998 to 2011. I have been the co-ordinator of the Southern Bullmastiff Society Welfare since 1997. I have also served as a committee member of Dunstable and District Canine Society. I am currently Treasurer of the Southern Dogue De Bordeaux Club and Breed Health Co-Ordinator for Dogue De Bordeaux.

## BARRY BLUNDEN

I have been around dogs for as long as can remember, initially working gun dogs. However, I wanted a Great Dane from the first time I watched Scooby Doo as a child. I bought my first Great Dane in 1990, a mis-mark harlequin named Barney, this boy, truly cemented my passion for the breed. I sadly lost Barney to DCM aged 5 1/2 years. I realised I couldn't be without one of these special dogs in my life, so I took on a rescue bitch aged 11 months, Molly, she stayed with me for almost 10 years. I had always attended dog shows, watching, and secretly wishing the winner was my dog, so I took the plunge and with the help of Jack Taylor, I bought my first dog to possibly show, my girl Phoebe, I had a good argument with Jack about which to choose, I won, he completely disagreed with me, however after she won her first best in show, he graciously shook my hand, and said, "I got that wrong, she grew into a beauty". After that I was hooked. I have been showing Great Danes since 2004, and judging since 2010. I have bred 3 litters, from three generations, totalling 20 puppies, 5 of which have remained with me. My dogs have had their share of wins, and losses, however, more important, I have made friends from my time with this truly amazing breed, I would never have even had the opportunity to meet. Most will be friends for life, and some I consider my family. Great Danes really are the most magical of breeds, and I feel proud to be able to judge them.

## THE GREAT DANE BREED COUNCIL

It has been brought to the Council's attention that the temperament in Great Danes is deteriorating. Therefore this notification will be in Schedules and Catalogues. It is intended as a guide to both Judges and Exhibitors.

### K.C. Rule 15 – Exclusion of Dogs

If in the opinion of the Show Secretary, Show Manager or Judge any dog is considered not in a fit state for exhibition owing to disease, savage disposition or any other cause, the dog may be excluded from the Show on the instruction of the Show management. Once excluded or removed from the Show the dog must not be brought into the Show at any time under any circumstances and the case must be reported in full to the Kennel Club within 7 days.

Judges may send the dog out if the dog appears to have an aggressive disposition.  
Extract from Kennel Club Regulations F(1) reproduced with their permission.

## REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F(B)

- These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A 42.
  - A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained there at.
  - Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A42.
  - No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present at any time during the Show.
  - Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:-
  - Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
  - The removal of dew claws of any breed.
  - Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.
- Nor must anything be done calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
- The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the K.C. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.

Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint
